



30-Hour OSHA Construction Safety & Health Program

Prerequisite: For this training course, there are no prerequisites. However, participants must be able to communicate effectively in the language used for instruction.

Audience: The 30-Hour OSHA course, mandatory for construction workers, supervisors, and safety personnel as per Local 196, is an intensive program covering occupational safety and health hazards. It is also required for those applying for roles like Site Safety Manager, Coordinator, and Superintendent, depending on qualifications.

Event Description: The 30HR OSHA Construction Safety and Health Training, created by the US Department of Labor, delves into OSHA's rules and construction safety principles, prioritizing high-risk areas. Upon completion, students get a certificate and, within 4-6 weeks, an OSHA-issued laminated course card.

Event Logistics: 123 4 Safety Group Training School provides OSHA and Scaffold operation certifications, featuring classroom presentations on equipment, hands-on practice with industry-standard and new products, and real equipment operation in a state-of-the-art facility, giving students practical job site experience.

- Recognize employer requirements for providing a safety and health program that effectively reduces and prevents employee injury, illness, and fatality
- Identify responsibilities of a supervisor in preventing worker injuries and unhealthful exposures
- Recognize the specific legal responsibilities of a supervisor to protect worker safety and health
- Identify the reasons for an incident investigation and future preventative measures that may result
- Describe types of health and safety construction hazards and appropriate forms mitigation

CEU Criteria: For Learners looking to obtain CEUs, participants in the OSHA 30 class will earn 3 CEUs, calculated as follows: CEUs for OSHA 30 = [30 Total Contact Time (Hours)] / [10 (Hours)] = **3 CEUs**.
